REGISTRATION

Inscription of fencers and referees according to be undertaken by National Federations at EFC Website.

EFC Licence

All fencers under 23 years old need an EFC Licence

Under 23 fencers on 1st January 2020

REFEREES

1-4 fencers = no referee required

5-9 fencers = 1 referee

10+ fencers = 2 referees

Non-respect of quota will result in penalty of €500 [Euros] for every referee not provided.

EQUIPMENT

FIE approved equipment. 800N Clothing (including glove), 1600N masks and Homologated Blade. Printing of the fencer's name on the back of the jacket is NOT required.
