Registrations

The EFC Circuit competitions continue to be open for all interested fencers, including those from other regional zones.

All fencers participating in the Circuit competitions must be aged U23, i.e. the fencers who can participate at the European U23 Championships in the same fencing season, thus reaching 23 years on or after the 1st of January of the year when the European Championships are to be held.

Only the central offices of Federations can enter fencers, coaches and referees respecting the EFC quota. The deadline for inscriptions is 1 week before the day of the event.

All **fencers, teams, coaches and referees** must be in possession of an EFC license (fee of 25 EURO) and entered by their respective National Federation respecting the above-mentioned deadline policy. Entering the fencer, coach or referee after the deadline is sanctioned by a penalty: for a fencer or coach 50 EUR per person, for a referee 100 EUR per person. (See [EFC Administrative Rules](#), p. 1.6)

No late entry or retirement for injury will be noted after 12:00 midday on the day preceding the competition. At this moment the registration is closed.

Entry fee

Individual tournament: **40,00 EUR / 500 NOK** per fencer

Team tournament: **100,00 EUR** per team

Entry fee can be paid in cash or by card at registration/payment.

Referee Obligation

Individual competitions

- 1-3 registered fencers: no referee
- 4-9 registered fencers: 1 referee
- 10-15 registered fencers: 2 referees
- 16-24 registered fencers: 3 referees

Team competitions:

- 1 referee per team

For the U23 referees should have a valid EFC-C / FIE B/A qualification.

In a transitional phase during the season 25/26 good national qualification is accepted.

Non-compliance of the quotas is sanctioned by 500 EUR for every missing referee per day of competition. A referee can only be registered for one event per day.

Individual tournament

FIE JWC formula, i.e. one round of pools followed by Direct Elimination (DE).

From the round preceding the DE table at least 20% and maximum 25% of participants should be eliminated.

Team tournament

Integral direct elimination with a direct elimination table, which may be incomplete. All places in the table up to 16th place will be fought for.

One team per country can be registered. Two teams are allowed from the organizing country.

Mixed teams composed of fencers from different countries cannot be entered.

Awards

- Four best fencers in men's individual competition
- Four best fencers in women's individual competition
- Three best teams in team competitions, men and women

Equipment and weapon control

According to FIE rules, weapon control on the pistes by referees.

The fencer's name on the back is optional.
